Pickup location for day trips:

Carney Park and Ride - Just 1 block north of Joppa, left off of Harford Rd. Timonium Park and Ride - On Deereco Rd between Timonium Rd and Padonia Rd.

TO RESERVE YOUR PLACE FOR A TRIP:

- Use a <u>Trip Reservation Form</u> for each trip you want to take. See Travel at <u>www.seniorboxoffice.org</u> for additional forms.
 - o If more than one person is going, please include name, telephone number, address and emergency number for each person on reservation form.
 - Please include your pick up point Carney or Timonium.
 - o If asked for in the advertisement for that trip, please include your meal choice and any dietary needs, as appropriate.
- Include a separate check, **payable to SBO Travel**, for each trip with the name of the trip included on the check.
 - The check should cover the full amount for day trips or the specified deposit for overnight trips.
 - Full payment for overnight trips must be sent in by the date specified in the trip notice in the brochure. Final payment dates are determined by the facilities with which we are working, often 30-60 days prior to the trip. Travel insurance is available for overnight trips.
- Include a **self-addressed stamped envelope** with each request.

Your bus seat is determined by the date of receipt of full payment.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

- **Day Trip:** Full refund if cancellation is received by trip leader 30 days prior to trip, except where otherwise stated in the advertisement as with non-refundable theatre tickets.
- Overnight trips: Unless otherwise stated in the advertisement, full refund will be made if cancellation is received in our office 30 calendar days prior to the trip. Otherwise, you are at liberty to find your own replacement, notifying SBO of the change, and making your arrangement with them.
- If cancellations are made after time limits listed above, a full refund will be made only if there is a replacement for your reservation.

COST: \$100 includes transportation, admission, box lunch, taxes and tip.







CASTLES OF NEW YORK & THOUSAND ISLANDS

4 Days - 3 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 An early departure has you heading for Upstate New York and the **Thousand Islands** region near the Canadian border. Upon arrival you will check into the **Edgewood Resort** along the St. Lawrence River. You will have time to freshen up before enjoying a delicious **dinner** at the hotel, which is followed by a relaxing evening.
- Day 2 After breakfast at the hotel, you will depart for the dock in downtown Alexandria Bay to board Uncle Sam's Boat for cruise along the St. Lawrence River and tours of two castles. Your first stop will be at Dark Island for a guided tour of Singer Castle which was built by the Bourne Family in 1905. Afterwards, enjoy the beautiful scenery as you cruise along the St. Lawrence River on the way to Boldt Castle. A boxed lunch will be provided. Arrive on Heart Island to visit Boldt Castle for a self-guided tour of the interior of the castle. The Castle was built as a monument of love by George Boldt for his wife, Louise. After your visit, you will cruise back to the dock. Return to your hotel to freshen up before departing for another delicious dinner at the hotel this evening.
- Day 3 Following breakfast at the hotel, depart for Clayton, NY to visit the Antique Boat Museum, the premier freshwater boating museum in North America with collections featuring over 320 unique boats and thousands of related artifacts and archives. The 4.5 acre campus comes alive with speedboat rides, a working skiff livery, and educational programs. Afterwards, visit the Thousand Islands Museum, a quaint museum that features an eclectic display of community artifacts and photographs with a gallery of permanent and rotating exhibits as well as a library. The Museum describes life in Clayton through the years and is dedicated to collecting, preserving, and exhibiting artifacts and historical records of the St. Lawrence River and Thousand Islands communities. In the afternoon you will arrive in Alexandria Bay for lunch on your own in the area. In mid-afternoon, depart for a visit to the Thousand Islands Winery for a tasting of their wines. Return to your hotel to relax and freshen up before enjoying another delicious dinner at the hotel.
- Day 4 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for home with fond memories of your visit to the Castles of New York and the Thousand Islands!

Grounds for Sculpture Hamilton, New Jersey Wednesday, October 15



Grounds for Sculpture is a museum, sculpture garden and arboretum where art and nature are always at play. Outdoors, nearly 300 sculptures, including Renoir's painting the Boating Party, are visible in the 42 landscaped acres. Indoors there are 6 galleries with changing exhibits. The park opened in 1992 on the former New Jersey State Fairgrounds. The sculptures range from traditional to humorous as you see a crowd sculpture just outside the park featuring a lady with a bag of groceries and someone waving. It is a charming place to visit. Lunch is on your own either at the Van Gogh Cafe or for a sit-down meal try Rats Restaurant (reservations recommended at 1-609-584-7800 or ratsrestaurant.com). We will arrive at the park around 11:30.
