Visitors can join a guide and walk the halls of this historic structure and learn about its architectural features, artwork, and the thousands of other authentic collection items that are on display. The mansion's artifacts and decor is changed twice a year - once in the winter and again in the summer to showcase seasonal fashions and adjustments that predate modern utilities and luxuries. Tickets are required to join a mansion tour. Tickets are free but limited. Tickets area available on a first come, first serve basis at the park visitor center.
